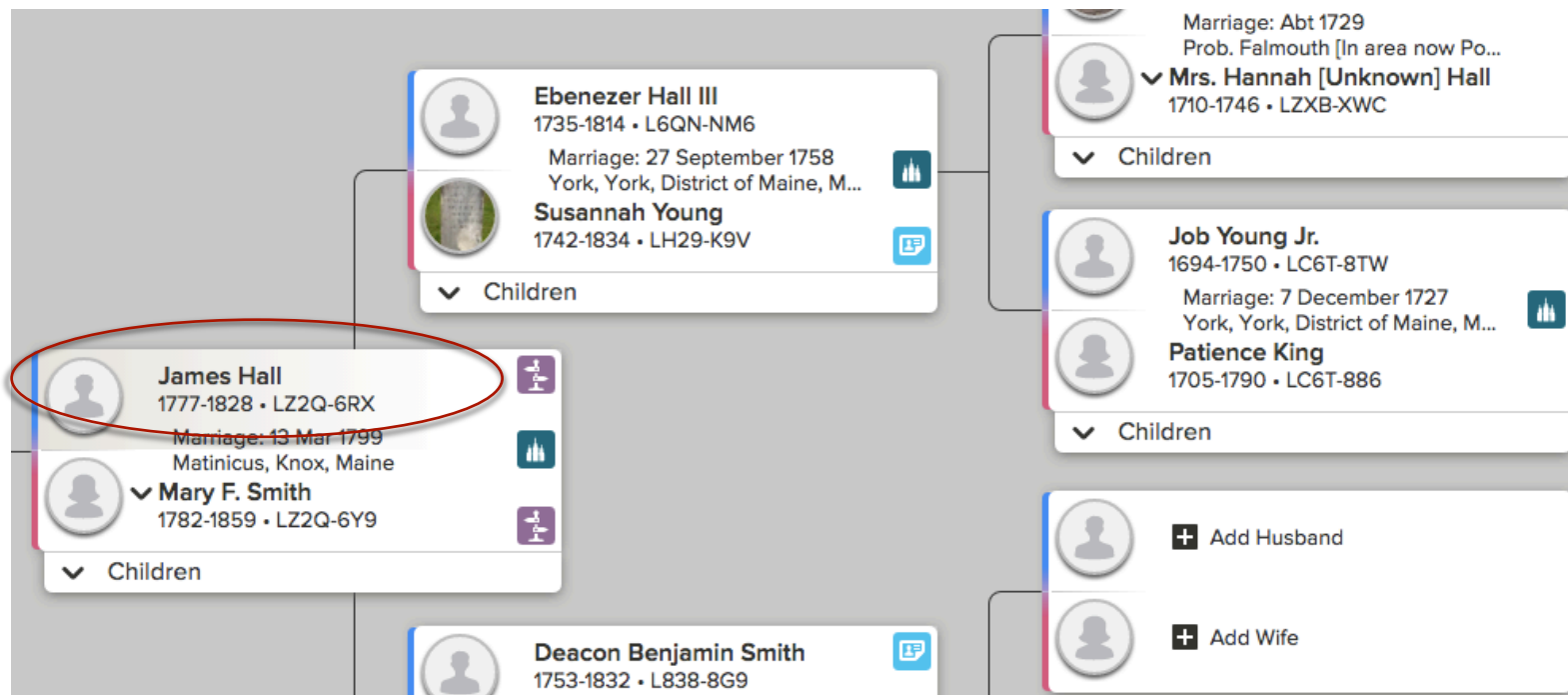

1. Sign in to FamilySearch with your LDS account by clicking “Sign In” in the upper right hand corner.
2. If you don’t have an LDS account, click “Free Account” in the upper right hand corner to set up your account.



Find an ancestor on your family tree who was born before 1830. Go back far enough that the descendants of this ancestor were born more than 110 years ago. For those born less than 110 years ago, permission is needed to do temple work.



Click once on the name of your ancestor.

On the summary card pop-up, click “Tree” to move him/her into the primary position in your family tree.



With your ancestor now in the home position, click the “View: Descendancy” icon  in the top left corner. To view the fan chart, click the “View: Fan Chart” icon  .

Each family unit card includes a 'Children' dropdown menu, indicating that there are more family members listed below the visible ones.

The Fan Chart feature allows you to see where the holes are in your tree, i.e., missing parents or spouse(s), giving you some good research options. See *Navigating the Fan Chart View* on [www.provoeastfhc.org](http://www.provoeastfhc.org)





The Descendancy feature will help you find possible temple work to perform on behalf of your cousins, the descendants of your ancestors. Click the “Show” icon and make sure the “Request Ordinances” box is checked, along with any other icons for additional information you want displayed. Note you can display up to 4 generations (recommended).

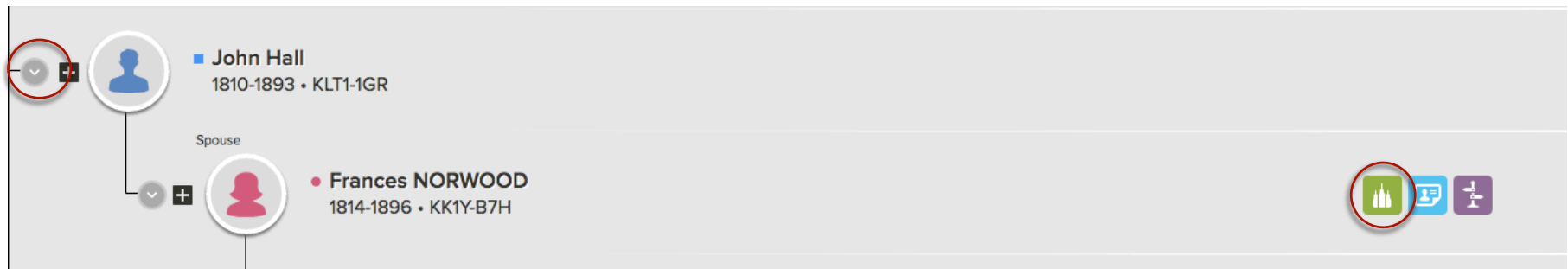

Clicking on the green temple icon will allow you to see the Request Ordinances dialog box, which shows all ordinance information.

According to the ordinance information for Frances Norwood, the baptism, confirmation and sealing to spouse are completed, the initiatory and endowment have been reserved but have not been printed, and the sealing to parents can be requested. If no duplicate records are found, click the blue “Request” button.
