Your Bishop or Elder's quorum presidency should have a Key fob for you.



Some of you may not need a fob to open the stake doors especially in evening shifts because the front doors are open for other activities, but you will need to learn the combination for the door to the center.

You are about HIS work.



- Pray for guidance
- Watch for ways to serve
- Expect miracles
- Sign in each day

Over the sign-in book is a question display. When you cannot answer a question, have the patron write it down with their email, phone number, and a good time to call back, so other consultants can help answer questions.

Ask visitors what they hope to accomplish



- Listen to their desires, and see if you can help.
- Ask them to sign in by bringing the sign-in book to them if they haven't signed in.
- Your graciousness will help them feel confident to do more.
- Point out the bulletin displays and point out something you like about what is contained there.

When you leave

- Turn off all lights, air conditioning and heat.
- Lock and check all doors.
- Close the curtains.
- Check outside door that it has latched if you leave through back door of building.
