



Free Ancestral Quest Basics Program

Ancestral Quest 16 is available in two versions. Ancestral Quest Basics is free genealogy software that has the essential features for working with your family tree, including some updated features in accessing FamilySearch Family Tree. The full Ancestral Quest program adds even more abilities and features that make it *the complete family history solution*. (If you've already been using Ancestral Quest Basics 15, you'll want to upgrade to Ancestral Quest Basics 16 for free.)

It is compatible with Windows 10, Windows 8.x, Windows 7, Vista and XP. Ancestral Quest and Ancestral Quest Basics, versions 14, 15 and 16, all require OS X 10.7 (Lion) through macOS 10.14 (Mojave). *Note: macOS 10.15 (Catalina) was released recently. It will not run 32-bit apps. Ancestral Quest 16 is currently a 32-bit app. Incline Software is working on a 64-bit version for Mac, which we hoped would be ready prior to the release of Catalina, but it has been delayed. Until the 64-bit version of AQ is ready, if you haven't already upgraded your Mac to Catalina, we recommend that you delay upgrading to Catalina, so that you can run Ancestral Quest. You need 400 MB hard disk space.*



Ancestral Quest *Basics* is more than just a trial version — it is a complete family tree program which contains the core features of Ancestral Quest. You will be able to easily organize your family history. The Basics version contains fewer advanced features, but is **absolutely free**.

4. Download the latest version of Ancestral Quest 16

• Only the open folder option of the top toolbar is available.



• You are given seven options for bringing in the data into the *Ancestral Quest 16* standalone program that are illustrated on the next page.

5. Select Import from *FamilySearch*

If you are starting your tree by downloading one family and their parents and children, then select option four "Import from FamilySearch."


You will be told to define a destination path (a file name) with a reminder window like this:



Click **OK**. A "Create New Family File" window will open. It may automatically prepare your file to be saved under your "Documents" folder, but putting them on a flash drive makes them portable so you can work at home or at the FHC on the same file. So, I change the location in my window from "Documents" to the drive where my flash file "15 AQ BKUP" was inserted.

To get started, choose one of the following options:




6. Tell AQ where to save your file.

I selected the option to locate my flash drive called 15 AQ BKUP. This window indicates it will put my file on that flash drive.

There is no file name, however, so you must give a name for your file. Put your cursor in the **File name** window and type in the name.

I entered **Rood Nelson** for my file name. Please take a moment to find the file name on the next page appearing as the title line after the name of the program **Ancestral Quest – Rood Nelson Family.**




Did you find the Rood Nelson name. I did not enter the word "Family". That was done by AQ.

7. Gain access to FamilySearch Family Tree (FSFT). Accept the agreement and enter your FSFT user name and **password**. If using your own computer, do click "Remember this ID".

AQ reminds you of your file name here. My thumb drive was in drive G with the name **Rood Nelson** and file extension .aq


8. Import Ancestors/Descendants from FamilySearch





Purpose: The research timeline is intended to help you see clues that will assist you in researching your family history. Sometimes, when you see pertinent events that may have affected your ancestors, it draws your attention to other resources you could look at to learn more about them.
	Note: Only events in your database that have a date will be shown on the timeline. For example, if you have a general fact, like "nationality," with no date, it will not be shown. Similarly, if a person has a relationship – either marriage or other – and you have not entered a date for that relationship, then the relationship will not be shown on the timeline.





When we click on Frederick Rood's name, the program opens on with Frederick as head of household. Notice he has an * by Other **Parents.** This means he has two sets of parents since he was adopted. Researcher is working on both lines.

 His spouse and children are missing because we haven't asked for his descendants yet.

14. To add a new spouse and children when you have an existing family click on the *FamilySearch* tool and select **Review/Sync Individual**.





Leslie F. Rood and Leslie Frederick Rood are the same person.

One was listed as deceased but researcher knew he was alive as he was her grandfather so she tried to merge the deceased into the living, but FSFT asked her to verify he was alive. That took 25 hours, but she didn't have to wait at AQ as shown next.




Notice caution: You will need to link the parents in each family (or at least mark them to be linked) before you will be able to selectively sync other events and link children. I clicked the blank box, it changed to green, for the mother so now the children appeared below.

AQ then tells you there is no matching child for the child Thomas. Mark the blank box, as you did with the spouse.



Continue in this manner through all the children of the parents. Notice the duplicate child is still here. I just clicked the one I knew was alive and can merge the duplicate at FSFT when permission arrives.

When done with marking the last one, click the last **OK**.



All those with a green back arrow will move to my AQ file.

Click the **Process** button at the bottom of the Synchronize template for it to Synchronize families between your database and FamilySearch
